| MBIE MIQ | Customs MBIE Immigration NZ | Identity details Passenger information | Establish or verify a person's identity. |
| MBIE MIQ | Ministry of Health/DHBs | Physical or mental health conditions (for returning New Zealanders only) | Asked for by exception only if an incident gives rise to a need during managed isolation or quarantine. |
| MBIE MIQ | MBIE Immigration NZ – may have some information on non-compliance Criminal history information is held by New Zealand Police. | Compliance history (MBIE/ INZ) Criminal history (NZ Police) only if specifically requested | To make exemptions decisions Note: No general sharing of information occurs between Police and MIQF. In response to specific requests only information of a serious nature is shared, including if a person has convictions. |
| MBIE MIQ | Oranga Tamariki, Police; MIQ, other agencies as appropriate | Information on Oranga Tamariki involvement for individuals | Information exchange occurs prior to an unaccompanied minor arriving for isolation in MIF/MQF, and relates to identifying and addressing any care or protection concerns for the child or young person in the MIF/MQF. A Memorandum of Understanding between New Zealand Police and Child, Youth and Family (July 2013) enables information to be shared between Police and Oranga Tamariki. | MBIE MIQ | Customs | Crew information. | To facilitate transport plans to and from managed isolation and quarantine of crew |
| MBIE MIQ | MBIE Immigration NZ | Whether an individual is an NZ citizen ordinarily resident in the Realm travelling through New Zealand to return to Realm; or travelling to NZ for medical treatment | To determine if a person is eligible for an exemption for MIF fees |
| MBIE MIQ | MBIE Immigration NZ | Whether an individual is a transit passenger and air or marine but not a New Zealander | To determine if a person is eligible for an exemption for MIF fees |
| Customs | MBIE Immigration NZ MoH | Transport plan (marine crew changes and exemptions) | To facilitate transport plans to and from managed isolation and quarantine of crew A similar process may be required for small vessels arriving in NZ where the people on board may need to isolate in MIQs. |
| MOH, Police | Customs | Passenger and flight information | To check on health status and provide information to those who are isolating. | MoH | MBIE Immigration NZ | Information about passengers and crew travelling to New Zealand | Enable the MoH to create an accurate Border Health record, find NHI numbers for arriving passengers and enable management of testing requirements at the border in MIQF, and initiate contact tracing where needed |
| MOH/DHB | MBIE (MIQ) | Information for mandatory MIQF staff testing. | Submission of employee identification details to enable NHI matching to confirm mandatory COVID testing has been performed in accordance with the COVID-19 Public Health Response (COVID-19 Testing) Order 2020 |
| MBIE MIQ | MOH/DHBs | Aggregate MIQF staff testing information | Confirming number of staff who have been tested or not |
| Police | MBIE MIQ | Contact details | Should circumstances require follow up after a person has left MIQ then Police would seek this information |
